- Do something for someone (home or school: a chore, clean up, a hug, a kind word)
- Cards for note of thanks:
 - Morning meeting, teacher model with a slide.
 - 1 card handwritten, more staff or parent appreciation can be sent via email.
 - A friend, a family member, teachers, staff, custodians, cafeteria staff, etc.

"Words that hurt, can't be taken back" and Charity

- Give a compliment to someone. The leading cause to conflict is people not taking the time to be nice. Sarcasm or jokes at other peoples expense should not be the "norm."
- Morning meetings can center around "what is charity?" Guest speakers welcome (other staff, family, a charity organizer?)
