Title 1 Academic Support Program: Parent Involvement Policy

The Magnolia School District's Academic Program encourages parents to be involved in their child's education. This policy outlines the parent involvement activities that will be conducted during the school year.

- Parents will receive a copy of the Parent Involvement Policy that describes the ongoing activities that are held to inform and involve parents in their child's education.
- Parents will receive a copy of the Home School Compact. This is an agreement between the family and school staff outlining everyone's responsibility for supporting student learning.
- An annual parent informational Zoom video recording will be emailed to all Title 1 parents after they've received the Title 1 Eligibility mailings.

This recording will present information that explains:

- how children are selected for the Support Program
- activities the children will experience
- how the children will be assessed to determine growth
- Parent-teacher conferences are scheduled at the end of the first and second trimesters. Learning interventionists will be available to review each child's progress and answer parents' questions.
- Newsletters, suggestions on how to work with children at home, lists of good books to read with children, and
 other information will be sent home periodically to provide parents with resources to assist their efforts in helping
 their children succeed in school.
- A survey will be given to the parents in the spring of each year that will allow parents a chance to offer suggestions and recommendations to help improve the Academic Support Program.
- Parents are invited to call the school or Learning Interventionist at any time during the year to discuss their child's progress in the Academic Support Program.
