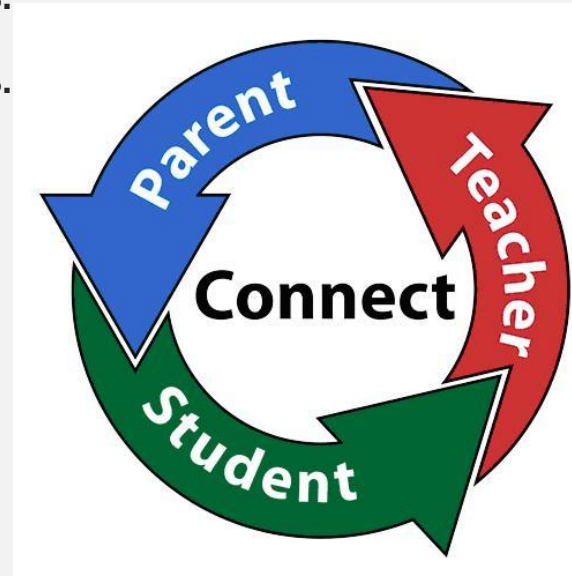
WHAT IS TITLE I?

- The program is intended to help ensure that all students meet state academic standards.



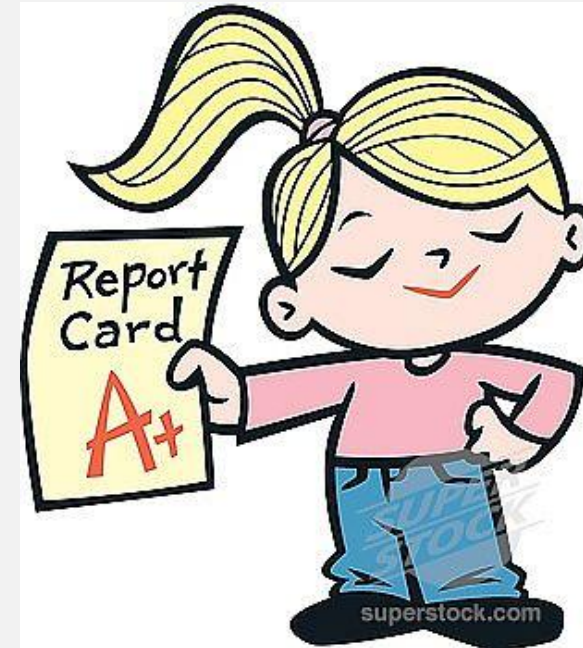
GOALS OF TITLE I
