The PTO would like to thank all parents, students and faculty who participated in collecting Box Tops for our school. Last year we reached our goal and collected \$1,200.

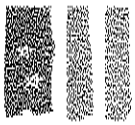
Box tops program is changing to become digital-only, however our school will continue to collect the traditional Box Tops clips.

**Purpose:** This activity is to encourage student involvement and to bring awareness of anti-bullying, anti-violence, anti-drugs and respect during Red Ribbon Week.

### Poster Guidelines:

**Message:** POSITIVE bullying prevention, POSITIVE drug prevention, POSITIVE violence prevention (How to stop or avoid) Pick a topic and include the theme of RESPECT.

**Size:** at least half a poster 11"x14" up to poster size 22"x28", can be done on any heavy weight art paper, cardstock or poster board.

**Art Materials:** markers, drawing pens, colored pencils, crayons, oil pastels-watercolor, acrylic, or tempera paints. No magazine or computer-generated images.

**Artwork:** must be original work of the student. Get creative and use your own ideas!

**Posters will be judged** by staff of MPS based on each student's creativity, originality, theme and message, and neatness of artwork.

**Student's name, grade and homeroom** should be printed neatly on the back of the poster.

**Grade Categories:** PreK-2, 3-5, 6-8

**Two winners from each grade range** will be chosen. The winners will receive a \$10 gift card to Wawa. The winners will be posted to our website and Class Dojo. All of the posters will be displayed in the school hallways.
