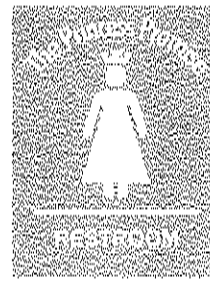
Finally, thank you for your support! As always, I couldn't do this without each and every student and parent's commitment to this program.

Dear Magnolia Public School Community,

Thanks to YOUR generosity in February, The Princess Promise was able to raise more than \$4,800 for the Crohn's and Colitis Foundation! February's Dress Down Day raised \$272, and I am so excited to partner with you again.

Inflammatory Bowel Disease affects "1 in 200 people in the U.S.," according to the Crohn's and Colitis Foundation. When I was Magnolia Mustang, I had no idea I would one day be diagnosed with IBD, an incurable autoimmune disease. In order to remain in remission and do things like earn my Master's degree (Class of '19), work full time, and live without the pain and panic a flare can bring, I receive infusions of an immune-suppressing drug called Entyvio every 8 weeks. **Thanks to donations from people like you, we are making strides to find a cure for this *lifelong* disease!**

I founded The Princess Promise to empower women with Inflammatory Bowel Disease with the promise that no matter what we experience, we are still princesses. From Q&A videos with doctors to tips for infusion days, The Princess Promise provides humor, inspiration, and information to women and men around the *world*.

Grade Categories: PreK-2, 3-5, 6-8

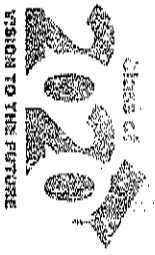
