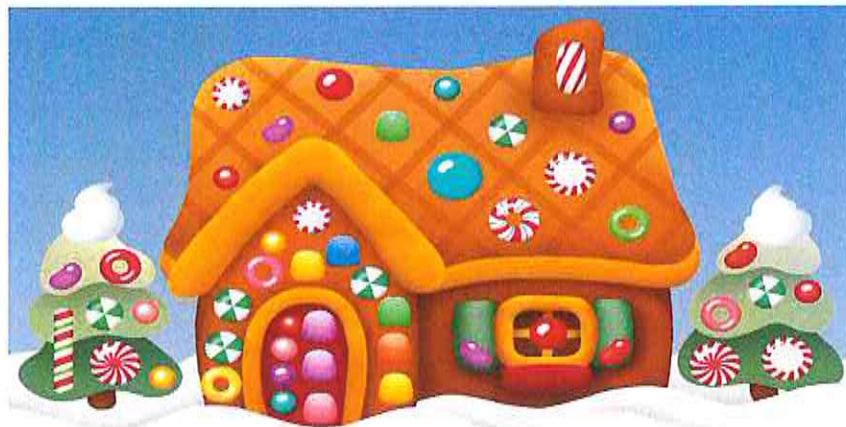
2019 GINGERBREAD HOUSE CONTEST
